

## Memorandum of Understanding and Cooperation

between

CHAMBER OF MEDIATORS OF THE REPUBLIC OF NORTH MACEDONIA

and

CENTAR ZA MIRENJE "MEDIJATOR" - REPUBLIC OF CROATIA

The Chamber of mediators of the Republic of North Macedonia and the Mediation center "Medijator" from the Republic of Croatia, express desire and readiness to establish cooperation in mediation as alternative dispute resolutions, it's development, trainings, promoting principles of mediation procedure and other related activities, do hereby commit to mutual and reciprocal cooperation to achieve shared goals.

The Mediation center "Medijator" is accredited institution for conciliation by the Ministry of Justice of the Republic of Croatia and is duly authorized for:

- conducting basic training for mediators,
- conducting advanced training for mediators,
- conducting training for educators of mediators,
- organizing and conducting mediation procedures,
- keeping a Register of issued Certificates and records of training participants.

In its work, the Mediation Center promotes the culture of dialogue, ethics and respect for diversity and develops good conciliation practice.

The Mediation center "Medijator" exchanges experiences in mutual support with related organizations in the ADR area.

Areas of cooperation may include any project or activity of mutual research for mediation development as alternative and adequate dispute resolution, further education for ADR methods, organizing courses and trainings for mediators and consultancy offered by either organization, which is desirable and feasible for the development and strengthening of cooperative relations.

Development of an agreement concerning any specific program or project will be contingent on mutual consent, availability of funds as well as subject of approval of each organization.

Such programs may include:

1. Mutual projects such as trainings abroad, study exchange with mutual visits, research, learning about mediation procedure, rules and principles, practical trainings, distance learning, continuing courses, cooperative trainings,
2. Exchanges for research, training or teaching for mediation procedure,
3. Collaborative research projects, workshops, debates, trainings, courses and organizing International events (conferences or seminars),
4. Exchanges of other proper and useful ADR information.

Supplemental agreement governing all areas of cooperation under the provisions of this Memorandum of Understanding and Cooperation shall be subject of negotiation and decided separately.

The agreed shall come into effect upon the signature of the duly authorized institutional representatives.

The agreement comes into force at the time of signing and is valid until the occurrence of other changed circumstances.
