

Memorandum of Understanding and Cooperation

between

CHAMBER OF MEDIATORS OF REPUBLIC OF NORTH MACEDONIA (“**CMRNM**”)

and

THE SWISS CHAMBER OF COMMERCIAL MEDIATION (“**SCCM**”)

CMRNM and SCCM, wishing to further good relations between our two organizations or their members in promoting mediation as a form of amicable dispute resolution (ADR), its development, training, and guiding principles, and other related activities, do hereby state our shared desire to cooperate in the future to achieve our shared goals.

Areas of cooperation may include projects or activities of mutual interest for the promotion of mediation as a form of ADR, education of different tools and techniques for mediation, courses and trainings for commercial mediators and other possible opportunities for the exchange of useful information or best practices, in the mutual interests of both organizations, which are desirable and feasible for the development and strengthening of cooperative relations and the promotion of mediation globally. Any specific program or project will be contingent on mutual consent, availability of funds, and the approval of each organization on a case-by-case basis. Such programs may include:

1. Mutual projects, such as trainings abroad, study exchanges with mutual visits, research projects, learning about each organization's mediation procedures and culture, its rules and principles, practical trainings, distance or online learning or webinars, continuing professional development courses, and cooperative trainings;
2. Exchanges for research, training or teaching purposes relating to different approaches to mediation;
3. Collaborative research projects, workshops, training courses and international conferences or seminars relating to mediation; and/or
4. Exchanges relating to other forms of ADR.

This memorandum of understanding and cooperation shall not create any legally binding obligations on either party, and any projects shall be subject to supplemental agreements, which shall be negotiated and decided separately, and signed by duly authorized representatives of each organization on a case-by-case basis.

We look forward to strengthening cordial relations between our two organizations, and to collaborating to promote mediation locally and globally.


