&
ASSOCIATION OF GREEK MEDIATORS

Recognizing mediation as a widely established and successful peacemaking process and extrajudicial method of resolving disputes. Acknowledging mediation as an important tool in bridging gaps and building trust in individuals, businesses and communities. Appreciating the admitted benefits of mediation in resolving disputes with special reference to the continuation of established relationships.

Undertaking the challenge of promoting mediation in national and bilateral level through awareness activities, dissemination of knowledge and cross-border mediations.

Committed to opening a new channel of mediation services to the benefit of our societies with the aim of amicably resolving bilateral disputes and further advance economic and social relations

WE the Chamber of Mediators of the Republic of North Macedonia (CMRNM) and the Association of Greek Mediators (AGM), wishing to strengthen the relations between our two organizations and promote mediation, do hereby agree to work towards a mutual cooperation for achieving our shared goals.

Areas of cooperation will include any project or activity related to the development, dissemination, promotion, awareness and every day use of mediation, carried out by the joint efforts of the two organizations.

Pursuant to the above, signatories may jointly organize trainings, seminars, workshops & events, exchange best practices, set up systems for referral of cross-border cases, apply for European & international grants & projects, empower field research, offer observation opportunities to mediators, accommodate internships, provide consultancy & expertise and initiate any other related activities.


In achieving the above mentioned shared goals, each party may share available information about global ADR activities with its counterpart, encourage and facilitate its participation to other international networks of mediators.

This document sets out the general principles of this MoU. Any of the activities mentioned above will be provided for and governed by separate supplementary written agreements negotiated and jointly decided by the signatories and shall come into effect only upon the signature of their respective authorized representatives.

The agreement comes into force at the date of signing and is valid until freely revoked by either party.


